

Duty of Care, Ours and Yours

Smart Strokes is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for all Smart Strokes Conference participants. Our decisions and preventive measures will be guided by the requirements and recommendations of the Australian Federal, State and local health authorities. We are working with the venue on implementing preventative measures to reduce the potential spread of the COVID-19 virus at our Conference. Preventive measures include:

- Enhanced sanitisation of meeting and exhibit spaces and high touch areas
- Air purifiers in the meeting rooms and exhibition area
- Encouraging physical distancing at all times, where possible
- Face masks are not compulsory, but highly encouraged
- Hand sanitisers throughout the meeting and exhibition

The responsibility for a safe and healthy event environment (Duty of Care) is shared among the event organiser, venue and every participant. All Smart Strokes Conference participants are expected to adhere to and abide by the safety precautions implemented to protect against the spread of COVID-19.

As part of your Duty of Care responsibilities, you should not attend the Smart Strokes Conference if you:

- believe that you may have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19.
- have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and are not yet cleared as non-contagious by the health care team responsible for your treatment.
- have suffered symptoms of COVID-19 including but not limited to, a fever, cough, sore throat, headache, distorted sense of taste, shortness of breath chills, vomiting or any cold/flu like symptoms within the 72hours prior to the start of the event

Conference attendees should self-monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and are asked to contact the Smart Strokes Conference organiser at smartstrokes@theassociationspecialists.com if they experience symptoms of COVID-19 within 7 days after the Conference. Should any positive cases be reported within the 7-day timeframe, Smart Strokes will communicate this information to all registered participants. Any private health or personal data received by Smart Strokes will be treated as confidential.

Please note that by attending the Conference, you agree to adhere to the precautions and policies above and understand that you are knowingly and freely assuming all risks related to illness and infectious diseases, such as COVID-19, by attending this event. You understand that refusal to adhere to these policies and abide by these precautions may result in immediate removal from the event and cancellation of the registration, without receiving a refund.
